Install an exhaust fan like Broan Model L500L inline exhaust fan with a Model 80L internal variable speed controller. Electrical characteristics are 120VAC 2.2A per spec sheet.

### QUESTION AND ANSWERS

Q What is the existing electrical panel?

A Sq D Catalog Number NQOD42L225CU Series E2 240V 1 phase 3 wire. Use breakers QBL, QDL, QGL, QJL.

Q Are there any spare breakers?

A There are three spare spaces. The panel schedule is blank so it is unknown if there are any spare breakers

Q Looking through Toilet partition spec. Specs describe couple types of partitions. 1.01 A calls for "floor mounted" 3.02 H is describing floor to ceiling pilasters. Can you verify style of partitions?

A Floor Mounted Partitions

Q Specs call for metal partitions, elevation calls for "stainless stall partitions" can you please verify?

A Stainless Stall Partitions

Q Is concrete slab to be removed under demising wall between new toilets? Demising wall is to stay per the demo and architectural plan. Slab below it is to be removed? What is the construction type of this demising wall? Block or stud?

A Slab below demising wall will remain. Wall is concrete block.

- Q Note 2 on the demo plan shows walls being removed. What type of construction are these walls block or stud?
- A Most walls are concrete block. The wall separating the rest rooms from the storage rooms is a stud wall.
- Q Note 4 on the demo plan calls for the ceiling to be removed. Is the existing ceiling drop ceiling, drywall, plaster, etc?
- A Existing ceiling is painted plywood nailed to ceiling joists.
